

# Adult Introduction to Membership

Its purpose is to give you the information you need to make an informed decision regarding membership. We ask all adults interested in membership to attend the 11 week A.I.M. sessions. A.I.M. is a prerequisite to

membership here at St. Paul's. "Adults" include any High School youth or young adults that have not yet been confirmed LCMS. After completion of A.I.M. we ask you to contact your former church for a transfer/release of membership to St. Paul's.

If you've contacted the Church Office to have your name placed on the "prospect for membership" list, you will be notified when dates for the next A.I.M. session are determined. In the meantime, while you are waiting to take A.I.M., we encourage you to participate in all church activities.
